COMPETITION OUTLINE

With average unit sizes getting smaller in the Greater Toronto Area (GTA), the need for innovative new ways to make these spaces more flexible has never been more important. This competition series invites the next generation of designers to submit creative designs to transform a studio suite at Daniels on Parliament, Daniels' newest addition to the Regent Park revitalization, into a hyper-functional contemporary living space. The goal is to challenge students' creativity and provide important collaborative opportunities that allow designers to apply their design ideas in a real-world application. Through this competition, we hope to motivate designers to challenge traditional notions of space and function and explore new, sustainable, and affordable ways for urban living.

The competition begins with inviting post-secondary design institutions to compete within each school. Each school will go through their own judging round and put forth their top team to advance to the next stage. Daniels will then invite these teams to present their design proposals in a live setting and select the top three winning teams. The first-place winner will have an opportunity to work with Daniels to further develop and build out the winning design.



DANIELS ON **PARLIAMENT**

Currently under construction at Parliament and Gerrard, Daniels on Parliament is located where Regent Park meets Cabbagetown and offers the epitome of high-rise urban living. The spectacular 25 storey South Tower not only boasts stunning views of downtown Toronto- it's also connected to the North Tower of Daniels on Parliament, sharing incredible amenity spaces for residents to enjoy.

At Daniels on Parliament, you will find a collection of beautifully designed homes ranging from modern studios to 2-storey walkouts. Just outside your door, you'll discover endless opportunities

to explore. Enjoy local culture, a vibrant art scene, great dining as well as shopping, cafes and schools. And, with the TTC at your doorstep, you're close to everything that makes downtown special.

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CONSTRAINTS AND RULES

Teams of four (4) members maximum will use the base floor plan shown below to develop an innovative studio space design. The types of design intervention may include elements such as unique storage solutions, millwork design, multifunctional small space furniture, and new technology in furniture design. Each team will be provided a set of files/documents relevant to the project and specific competition suite upon registration.



= elements can be changed/shifted

Fixed elements to remain:

- Suite entry door and anything outside of the suite
- Suite and corridor demising walls
- Structural elements
- Pipe Chase locations (i.e. kitchen plumbing chase, laundry plumbing chase)
- Electrical and Communication panel locations

Elements that can be changed:

- Addition of interior walls
- Addition of electrical receptacles

- Bathroom plumbing fixtures can be shifted slightly and/or swapped out for an alternative spec
- Kitchen plumbing fixtures and appliances can be shifted slightly and/or swapped out for an alternative spec
- Suite finishes can be swapped out for an alternative spec
- Elements can be attached or hung from the structural slab in areas where ceiling space is available

RECOMMENDED PRESENTATION ELEMENTS

- Floor Plan with Furniture Layout
- Reflected Ceiling Plan (RCP)
- Elevations
- Furniture Specifications/Details
- Finishes Specifications/Details
- Renderings
- Digital 3D Model/Animation to show flexibility/uses of multifunctional furniture (if applicable)

COMPETITION TIMELINE

DESIGN PHASE

1. Registration (beginning March 2024)

Student teams to register through the competition webpage. All participants must fill out the registration form and submit a signed media waiver to enter the competition. Media waiver and other supplementary CAD files required for the competition can be downloaded <u>here</u>.

2. Charette (March to early-June 2024):

Submissions deadline is May 31st, 2024. Submissions to be uploaded through the competition webpage. Each school to run internal charette to narrow down to 1 finalist team per school. The finalist teams to be submitted to Daniels by June 7th, 2024.

3. Daniels Review (Mid-June 2024):

The finalist team from each of the schools will be invited for an in-person design presentation. Each presentation to be 15 minutes, with a 5-minute feedback/critique session. The 3-finalist teams will be short-listed and announced at the end of the presentations.

4. Internal Review and Selection of Winners (Mid-June):

The Daniels panel will meet internally to rank the three (3) winning teams. The final decision will be relayed by June 21st, 2024 to all participating student teams.

WORKING DRAWING PHASE (June to August 2024)

Daniels to work with design consultants and Contracts & Estimating team to best realize the winning teams' design intent and translate into a set of working drawings to be used for fit-out of the design. Winning student team will be engaged as needed for any design changes and related coordination. Winning team will be invited for a site walkthrough in Fall 2024.

FIT-OUT COMPLETION (December 2025)

Winning student team invited to the completed suite for a walkthrough with Daniels, with opportunity to highlight students' perspective on their competition journey and learnings.

AWARDS

First Place Winner:

Team cash prize of \$5,000

- Opportunity to work with Daniels and design consultant teams to further develop design for build out.
- Competition winners will be announced in a press release and receive mention on Daniels corporate website and social media.

Second Place Winner:

- Team cash prize of \$3,000
- Competition winners will be announced in a press release and receive mention on Daniels corporate website and social media.

Third Place Winner:

- Team cash prize of \$2,000
- Competition winners will be announced in a press release and receive mention on Daniels corporate website and social media.

Peoples Choice Winner:

- Team cash prize of \$1,000
- Competition winners will be announced in a press release and receive mention on Daniels corporate website and social media.
